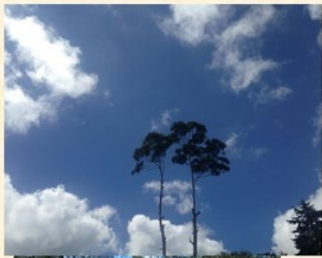


Sri Lankan Tales - Day 3
