

PRIMARY SCHOOL SCIENCE AND TECH FEST

The 'Science and Tech Fest' held in the Primary School was a way to challenge the students and expand their knowledge to help them explore Science behind everyday happenings.

All the students from pre-nursery to grade 5 participated in the Science-Tech Fest in the Primary School. Students from Grades 1 to 5 practised their scientific skills when they conducted the scientific experiments on their own, guided by their teachers in the classrooms and the Science Room.



The Technology aspect of the Fest was addressed during the week through an Inter-House quiz which was conducted for students of Grades KG to Grade 5. The quiz was keenly contested by the students.

Students of Early Years analysed the optical illusion displays and provided their perspective. They also observed the interesting experiments conducted by their teachers. An interesting aspect was the menu for the snacks written in scientific terminology like protein and vitamin rich flavoured liquid and sliced *Malus domestica*.

There was a feel of science reflecting in each corner of the School. A mini museum was set up by the students of Grade 4 where scientific displays, models, charts were exhibited.



An interactive module of science experiments was conducted by professionals from 'Wonder Lab' who demonstrated experiments with dry ice, giant bubbles and liquid nitrogen. The students were thoroughly engaged in every demonstration they witnessed.
